
Border Assembly: Measure width and length of the quilt top to ensure border sizes, below are our cutting instructions. Follow the Quilt Diagram below.


- 5. Top/Bottom Borders: Sew (1) GH ROW to top and (1) to bottom of Quilt Center.
- 6. Side Borders: Sew (1) G 2-1/2" x 58-1/2" strips to left and right sides of Quilt Center.

FINISHING

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.

WOF = WIDTH OF FABRIC | *SEW STRIPS VIA SHORT ENDS | QST = QUARTER SQUARE TRIANGLES

BLOCK ASSEMBLY:

1. Sew (1) G triangle to (1) H triangle as shown. Press open. Make 36 GH triangle units.



GH TRIANGLE UNITS (Make 36)

2. Sew (2) GH pieced triangles units together (note rotation) to create GH BLOCK. Square to 4-1/2". Make 18.

GH BLOCK (Make 18)

Sew together (9) GH BLOCKS as shown in the diagram below to create GH Row. Make 2.



QUILT CENTER ASSEMBLY:

4. Sew (1) B strip to left and (1) to the right side of (1) A panel. Then sew (1) C strip to left and (1) to the right side of BAB Unit. Sew (1) D strip to top and (1) to bottom of Quilt Center, as shown in diagram below. Sew (1) E strip to left and (1) to the right side of Quilt Center. Lastly, sew (1) F strip to top and (1) to the bottom of Quilt Center.
